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RYDE-EASTWOOD LEAGUES CLUB COVID-19 UPDATE 2

Members and Guests

In light of the recent developments of COVID-19 I wanted to assure all that we are monitoring and assessing the situation closely to ensure we act promptly and in accordance with NSW Health and Australian Government recommendations and directives.

The well being of our members, guests and staff is always the highest and number one priority for us and our measures to manage this are always for the long-term safety of all.

WHAT IS RYDE-EASTWOOD LEAGUES CLUB DOING?

Over recent weeks we have been constantly reviewing our current procedures and policies as well as determining Only in the last 24 hours many new restrictions and management policies have been put in place by the government that effect our operations. We have implemented a number of measures to ensure members, guests and employees are in an environment that is safe, while continuing to provide a service to the community.

MAJOR OPERATIONAL CHANGES

We have enforced the recommended 1.5mt social distancing in all areas of the club. This includes

CLUB ACTIVITIES

- Every second gaming machine is turned off to ensure good distance.
- All dining areas seating reduced to promote a social distance of 1.5mt or more.
- All Lounge seating reduced to promote a social distance of 1.5mt or more. Some areas closed to ensure this is managed
- Large events/entertainment and promotions cancelled or postponed. These will be updated on the clubs website as we move forward however include Buddy Holly Show, Retro Night, Line Dancing, Ceroc, Bingo, etc.
- Entertainment reduced or removed to background music.
- Club run social gathering cancelled including Poker, Raffles and Gaming Promotions

FUNCTIONS

- Function capacity measures and set up changed to ensure social distancing. Large or above limit events cancelled or postponed

THE FITNESS CENTRE

- Gym machines to be limited to promote social distance of 1.5mt or more. Signage to be placed advising patrons on our actions and reason.
- Group Fitness Classes limited to max 20 participants in GF studio as well as changes to class format to ensure distance with participants while training. Functional Classes limited to max 8 participants and again changed format. Aqua classes reduced to max of 25
- Creche bookings maximum of 8 at any one time. Minimum age of 3 years old able to attend

NEW GOVERNMENT MEASURES OF 100 PEOPLE OR MORE

The Federal Government today released new measures that restrict an non-essential indoor gatherings of greater than 100 people. It notes that these guidelines are based on certain parameters where in classes of areas in order to segregate people where possible in closed areas

- We have created sectioning of the clubs facility in line with the guidelines in order to manage and action
- We have removed or restricted additional seating in areas to ensure we monitor and manage these requirements
- We complete regular checks in areas to ensure we are compliant at all times
- The fitness centre is a separate area of the facility and remains open while we manage attendance in a manager to provide a safe and welcoming environment for members
- Functions remains open for smaller more essential events and functions to support community needs



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GENERAL MEASURES FOR PREVENTION

- We have increased provision of sanitizers across the Club and fitness centre for our staff and customers use
- We have removed self service cutlery from dining areas, and this will be provided by staff with meals
- We have increased the cleaning levels in all areas to ensure that high touch points are wiped down frequently with detergent and sanitiser
- We have engaged an additional contract cleaning specialist focusing on all areas including door handles, handrails, bathrooms and general surfaces throughout the Club and Fitness Edge
- We will monitor patrons entering the club for signs of illness and may request people displaying flu-like symptoms to stay away from the Club

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

We ask all members to follow the guidelines of NSW Health and the Australian Government measures. This includes:

- Cover your mouth and nose with your bent elbow or tissue when you cough or sneeze. Then dispose of the used tissue immediately
- Regularly and thoroughly clean your hands with an alcohol-based hand rub or wash them with soap and water
- Maintain social distancing
- Evaluate your own health and that of people you are in contact with
- If you begin to feel unwell in any way or show any signs of flu-like symptoms such as runny nose, sore throat or cough, we ask that you stay away from the Club for the wellbeing of all members and guests
- If you have returned from overseas, you must self-isolate and NOT attend the club until 14 days have passed and you show no signs of being unwell

We thank you for your continued support of our club and cooperation in observing these new hygiene protocols. Together we can ensure a safe environment and continue to create a place at the heart of our community for everyone to enjoy.
